■Report of present situation of CFF, and near future prospects

1. Philippines (Reported by Christine Joy Martin)

- i. Number of COVID-19 positive patients is increasing, but many of them have been recovered.
- ii. All children can't go to school, so they do many activities in CFF. (planting vegetable, making wallet, team building, skill training, cooking, online lesson)
- iii. Problem is short of manpower, they are trying to recruit some volunteer and OJT to help children.

2. Malaysia (Reported by Wilson Gan)

- i. Life in Sabah is getting normal, there are not so many positive patients around CFFM.
- ii. All children went back to school, two of them who already graduated from high school also went back to their normal life, their schedule are back to normal.
- iii. They are doing donation campaign, has collected RM4,000 now.

3. Myanmar (Reported by Mr. Maung Maung Yin, Hein Min Htet)

- i. COVID-19 situation is getting worse. Infection rate is rapidly increasing compared with last month, so Yangon area is almost lockdown.
- ii. CFF MY restarted sewing project, shared mask and face shield to children facility, had water project meeting.
- iii. Future plan is to own CFF classroom in order to teach some study programs for children who lives in poor area.

4. Japan (Reported by Naho Arima)

- i. COVID-19 situation in Japan is not so bad, but most of people don't want to go far places, trip. Therefore, CFF J think that it's difficult to hold 2021 spring program.
- ii. CFF Japan will run out of fund by the next year without 2021 summer program income.

iii. Near future prospects are to have online programs with each CFF and, to close CFFJ office until the end of this year to save costs.

Sir. RJ (CFFP) – CFFP will gather local donors for maintain CFFP.

Dr. Maung Maung Yin – CFF MY are going to have meeting about CFF present situation.

Sir. Jolo (CFFP) – He will ask Japanese company to support CFFJ.

And all CFFs should not be independent, CFF international foundation should be established.

For CFF international foundation, we need to set secretary general and office.

Ps. Chin (CFFM) – We need to establish foundation formally in order to manage fund in the future.

Ms. Tina (CFFP) – She will ask YMCA how they could own organization all over the world.

Ms. Maihara (CFFJ) – Support from company to CFF sounds difficult, but it's better to ask and try.

Mr. Abe (CFFM) – For the CFF foundation, each CFF needs to fund. And each CFF president should manage and check properly.

1. Each CFF will make a budget without income of cooperation program for the time being.
2. Each CFF will plan online program with CFF Japan.
3. To organize an international CFF foundation.
4. To update information for international website to Mr. Yoshino, and he will make format.
5. To have online international meeting regularly.

1. Mr. Jolo and Mr. Abe will discuss how to proceed an international CFF organization project.
2. Mr. Yoshino will make format for exchanging information website supported by CFFJ.
3. Mr. Jolo, and Mr. Abe will set up next meeting date.
